Who are Undergraduate School Presidents?

There is one undergraduate School President per Department or School, appointed every year in March via an application and appointment process. The role of the School President is to oversee and support the Course Reps in their School/Department and be a point of contact where a matter may need escalating further up the University. They build relationships with influential university staff and play a key role in monitoring and improving the academic experience at Loughborough University.

School Presidents meet with other volunteers within the education section, the Education Executive Officer and the Academic Representation Coordinator on a regular basis to discuss academic affairs, share best practice, and raise any issues that may need escalating. They are also invited to attend strategic Department meetings such as the Annual Programme Review meeting, and a discussion on the outcomes of the National Student Survey at the beginning of the year.

To become a School President, you must have previously been a Course Rep or School President. This is to ensure that you have a good understanding of academic representation and how the scheme works.

Responsibilities

- Lead, motivate and support your Course Rep team to effectively work alongside your Department
- Build strong relationships with senior members of staff in the Department
- Represent the views of undergraduate students in your Department (and postgraduate if your School doesn't have a PGT School President)
- Co-chair Student-Staff Liaison Committee (SSLC) meetings alongside your Department's SSLC Chair (don't worry there is lots of support for this)
- Deliver university level student feedback to the Education Executive Officer and work on university wide campaigns
- Organise pre-SSLC meetings with Course Reps to prepare for SSLC meetings
- Promote the Course Rep applications at the start of the academic year to students
- Act as a key communication link between the Students' Union, University and students
- Attend your Department's Annual Programme Review meeting (Jan/Feb)
- Assist with the promotion of the National Student Survey (NSS) Feb Apr
- Collaborate with senior education volunteers; Department Chair and Peer Support Student Coordinator

Role Requirements

- You must have previously been a Course Rep or School President
- Be a good listener
- Able to speak up on behalf of others
- Be motivated and driven
- Have good organisation and time management skills

Time Commitment

• We only ask that the Course Rep role takes approximately 1-2 hours per week so that this is manageable alongside your degree and any other responsibilities that you may have.

- A unique insight into how the University works
- It will put you in a good position to run for Education Executive Officer and other Union Executive positions
- Develop your transferable skills, such as problem-solving, negotiation, diplomacy, and time-management
- Receive recognition from the University at events such as the annual Loughborough Academic Awards, including 'School President of the Year'

Application and Appointment Process

Once the closing date and time has passed, all applications will be anonymised and reviewed by a panel of two staff and one executive member. School Presidents will only be appointed where their application demonstrates they are suitable for the role based on the role description above. Where there are more applicants than positions available, appointment will be made based on strength of application.
